As the dinners are prepared in St Patrick's kitchen, the cooks must know the numbers in advance.
- Collection of Children—Class Teachers should be informed of any changes to arrangements for collecting children. Please send a note to school with your child or email amcclements 388@c2kni.net before 12 noon.
- School absences must be reported in writing to your child's teacher as soon as possible, usually on your child's return to school. This ensures the correct absence code can be entered to the official attendance register. A pro-forma is available to download from the school website.
- Guidance on Infection Control in Schools—If your child has experienced vomiting or diarrhoea, the guidance from the PHA is that they should only return to school 48 hours after the last episode.
