

St. Anne's Primary School

- As detailed on the holiday list sent home at the start of the school year, the school will close at 12pm on Friday 16th March for St Patrick's Day. Dinner will be at 11.30am. 100% Attendance	0 Days Missed
95% Attendance	9 Days of Absence
90% Attendance	19 Days of Absence
85% Attendance	28 Days of Absence
80% Attendance	38 Days of Absence
75% Attendance	46 Days of Absence

90% may seem like an acceptable level of attendance, but the reality is that 90% attendance means that your child will miss half a school day each week or 19 days of school during the school year – that's nearly 4 school weeks!
