- Free School Meals—If you think that your child/children may be entitled to free school meals, online application forms are available to complete on the Education Authority Website: www.eani.org.uk. Any applications or enquiries are completely confidential. We encourage all who are eligible to apply, even if they do not intend to take a free meal, as our school funding can be supplemented by the Department of Education if we have a significant number of children entitled to free school meals.
- School Dinner—An online menu order for next week is available to complete on the school website. After completion, please send the fee in an envelope with your child's name on it by <u>Monday morning</u>. As the dinners are prepared in St Patrick's kitchen, the cooks must know the numbers in advance. Please note that St Anne's is no longer able to accept paper banknotes.
- P5-P7 Lunchtime Hurling/Camogie—Continues at lunchtime every day (weather permitting).
- Brain Gym—Continues for P7 pupils continues every Tuesday from 3-4pm.
