- School Dinner Price Increase: As from 1st January 2017 the price of a school dinner will be £2.55 per day (£12.75 per week). Due to limited change parents are asked to sent the correct money in an envelope with their child's name clearly marked on the outside. When paying dinner and milk money cheques should be made payable to: The Education Authority—NE Region. Everything else (After Schools, Breakfast Club etc.) should be made payable to St Anne's PS.
- St Anne's Breakfast Club will continue as usual from 8.00am until 8.50am every morning until the end of the year. If you wish your child/children to attend the breakfast club please send £2 per day in an envelope with your child's name and days they wish to take breakfast. As we need to know numbers for Monday can we ask that this is sent to school on the Friday before. Parents please note that supervision for children who are not attending the Breakfast club begins at 8.50am; children will not be permitted to enter the school building before this time.
