- 2018 P1 Enrolment Forms—any outstanding applications should be returned to the school as soon as possible. - St Anne's Breakfast Club will continue as usual from 8.00am until 8.50am every morning until the end of the year. P1 children may now attend. If you wish your child/children to attend the breakfast club please send £2 per day in an envelope with your child's name and days they wish to take breakfast. As we need to know numbers for Monday can we ask that this is sent to school, when possible, on the Friday before. Parents please note that supervision for children who are not attending the Breakfast club begins at 8.50am; children will not be permitted to enter the school building before this time.
- P1-P7 PE Lessons are held every Monday. Please ensure all pupils bring their PE gear to school with them.
- Swimming P6/7 will continue as usual on Wednesday. The cost is £3 per child per week.
