 The price of a school meal has increased to £2.60 per day or £13.00 per week. Dinners for the week (paid and free) should be ordered on a Monday morning by returning the correct money and slip attached.

 School Absences must be reported in writing to your child's teacher as soon as possible, usually on your child's return to school. This ensures the correct absence code can be entered to the official attendance register.

• EVERY SCHOOL DAY COUNTS

Every single day a child is absent from school equates to a day of lost learning.

100% Attendance	0 Days Missed
95% Attendance	9 Days of Absence
90% Attendance	19 Days of Absence
85% Attendance	28 Days of Absence
80% Attendance	38 Days of Absence
75% Attendance	46 Days of Absence

90% may seem like an acceptable level of attendance, but the reality is that 90% attendance means that your child will miss half a school day each week or 19 days of school during the school year.

- P1-P7 PE Lessons are held every Monday and Friday. P1, P2 and P3 will have PE on Mondays and P4, P5, P6 and P7 will have PE on Fridays. Please ensure all pupils bring their PE gear to school with them.
- P6 After Schools Brain Gym will continue as usual every Tuesday from 3.00-4.00pm
