Collection of Children

• Class Teachers should be informed of any changes to arrangements for collecting children.

- School absences must be reported in writing to your child's teacher as soon as possible, usually on your child's return to school. This ensures the correct absence code can be entered to the official attendance register. A pro-forma is available to print from the school website. Please ensure all details are included in any absence notes.
- Best Attendance—Well done to P7 who had the best attendance in September and P5 & P6 who had the best attendance in October.
- Brain Gym for P7 pupils will resume on Thursday 10th December to allow for Parent/Teacher interviews.
- Swimming There will be no swimming lessons until further notice
- Violin Tuition— Further information will follow after consultation with the EA Music Service.
- Loughguile Credit Union—School Savings will be collected every Friday (max £5 per lodgement). Wallets will be returned to pupils every Thursday.
- Hurling/Camogie with Dominic McKinley continues every Thursday for all pupils. Pupils should bring their own sticks and helmets to school with them. If they do not have these, the school can provide them. They will be sanitised before and after each use.
- Online Safety—We ask parents to reinforce online safety messages with their children and to regularly monitor their online platforms to ensure they are not accessing or participating in anything unsuitable. Most of these platforms have a minimum age limit, therefore not appropriate for children of primary school age. Many children have been known to be sending messages/interacting long after they should be asleep. Parents should delete any apps they deem improper. Please visit the NSPCC website which has a wealth of guidance and advice.
- School Dinner—Hot School Dinners are continuing on a trial basis. An online menu order for the week beginning Monday 30th November is available on the school website. <u>After completion</u>, please send the fee, if applicable, into school in an envelope with your child's name on by Monday morning (30th Nov). As the dinners are prepared in St Patrick's kitchen, the cooks need to know the numbers in advance.
