### School Dinners

 The price of a school meal is £2.60 per day or £13.00 per week. Dinners for the week (paid and free) should be ordered on a Monday morning by returning the correct money and slip attached.

#### Collection of Children

 Class Teachers should be informed of any changes to arrangements for collecting children.

- School absences must be reported in writing to your child's teacher as soon as possible, usually on your child's return to school. This ensures the correct absence code can be entered to the official attendance register. A pro-forma is available to print from the school website. Please ensure all details are included in any absence notes.
- Best Attendance—Well done to P1, P2, P3 & P4 who jointly had the best attendance in November.
- Brain Gym for P7 pupils will continue every Thursday from 3.00-4.00pm. Parents will have to collect their children from school as there will be no bus available at this time.
- Swimming There will be no swimming lessons until further notice
- Loughguile Credit Union—School Savings will be collected every Friday (max £5 per lodgement). Wallets will be returned to pupils every Thursday.
- Hurling/Camogie with Dominic McKinley continues every
  Thursday for all pupils. Pupils should bring their own sticks
  and helmets to school with them. If they do not have these,
  the school can provide them. They will be sanitised before and
  after each use.
- Online Safety—We ask parents to reinforce online safety messages with their children and to regularly monitor their online platforms to ensure they are not accessing or participating in anything unsuitable. Most of these platforms have a minimum age limit, therefore not appropriate for children of primary school age. Many children have been known to be sending messages/interacting long after they should be asleep. Parents should delete any apps they deem improper. Please visit the NSPCC website which has a wealth of guidance and advice.
- School Dinner—Hot School Dinners are continuing on a trial basis. An online menu order for Thursday 7th & Friday 8th January 2021 is available on the school website. After completion, please send the fee, if applicable, into school in an envelope with your child's name on by Thursday morning (7th Jan). As the dinners are prepared in St Patrick's kitchen, the cooks need to know the numbers in advance.
- St Anne's Breakfast Club is temporarily cancelled. Parents will be updated on when we can begin offering this service again.
