

St. Anne's Primary School

- Welcome back to our P1-P3 pupils who returned to school last Monday. We look forward to welcoming back to school all our P4-P7 pupils on Monday 22nd March. A letter from Mr Duffin outlining details of the school restart is available to view on the school website.
- Reminder of school start and finish times:
- P1, P2 and P7 pupils enter the school grounds from 8.50am, through the main pedestrian gate.
- P3, P4, P5 & P6 pupils enter the school grounds at 8.50am, through the lower pedestrian gate (P1-P2 play-ground).
- All children must go directly to their classrooms. Registration for all pupils is at 9.00am.
- P1 & P2 pupils finish at 2.00 pm and exit through the main pedestrian gate.
- P3 and P4 pupils finish at 2.40pm and exit through the lower pedestrian gate (P1-P2 playground).
- P5 and P6 pupils finish at 2.50pm and exit through the lower pedestrian gate (P1-P2 playground).
- P7 pupils finish at 2.50pm and exit through the main pedestrian gate.
- St Anne's will close for the Easter break at 12pm on Wednesday 31st March, as previously published on our holiday list. There will be no school dinner that day however, the school bus will be available to take the children to and from school. Class for all pupils will resume on Monday 12th April.
- Well done to our P3 pupils who celebrated their First Confession on Monday. Thank you to Fr Patsy, Mrs Black and Miss Lynn who helped prepare the children for this important sacrament.

Collection of Children

 Class Teachers should be informed of any changes to arrangements for collecting children.

- School absences must be reported in writing to your child's teacher as soon as possible, usually on your child's return to school. This ensures the correct absence code can be entered to the official attendance register. A proforma is available to print from the school website. Please ensure all details are included in any absence notes.
- Brain Gym for P6 pupils will begin on Tuesday 23rd March from 3.00-4.00pm. Parents will have to collect their children from school as there will be no bus available at this time.
- Swimming There will be no swimming lessons until further notice.
- Loughguile Credit Union—School Savings have been postponed until further notice.
- Hurling/Camogie with Dominic McKinley has been postponed until further notice.
- Online Safety—We ask parents to reinforce online safety messages with their children and to regularly monitor their online platforms to ensure they are not accessing or participating in anything unsuitable. Most of these platforms have a minimum age limit, therefore not appropriate for children of primary school age. Many children have been known to be sending messages/interacting long after they should be asleep. Parents should delete any apps they deem improper. Please visit the NSPCC website which has a wealth of guidance and advice.
- School Dinner—Hot School Dinners are continuing on a trial basis. An online menu order for next week is available to complete on the school website. After completion, please send the fee, if applicable, into school in an envelope with your child's name on by Monday morning (22nd March). As the dinners are prepared in St Patrick's kitchen, the cooks need to know the numbers in advance.
- St Anne's Breakfast Club is temporarily cancelled. Parents will be updated on when we can begin offering this service again.
- School Milk for April and May—Any pupil who ordered milk for January & February will have their order carried over for these two months as the money was paid in December.
- Any pupils who borrowed iPads from school to assist with home learning are kindly asked to return them to school on Monday 22nd March.
